Folk Art Friday Expectations

Folk Art Friday expectations are designed to ensure the safety of all participants as well as provide a fun and enjoyable time for everyone at the AG Museum.

1. Parents must sign their camper/s in and out daily or accompany them to the class.
2. LABEL EVERYTHING BROUGHT TO THE MUSEUM, so it goes home with the correct person. Including water bottles (NO GLASS)
3. Staff will not dispense medication.
4. Parents will be contacted if their minor becomes unruly during class. If the child continues to be unruly, the parent/guardian will be asked to pick up their child. No refund will be given if the child is removed due to behavior.
5. Respect the class instructors and obey Museum rules.
6. No fighting or hitting other participants. Be respectful of each other.
7. When a class instructor is talking, participants should remain quiet and raise their hand if they need to say something.
8. No running in the buildings or outside unless instructed to.
9. Participants are to always remain with the class.
10. If a participant is running fever or has any Covid-19 symptoms, please keep them at home. If symptoms appear while at class, the participant will be isolated from the group and parents will be contacted immediately.
