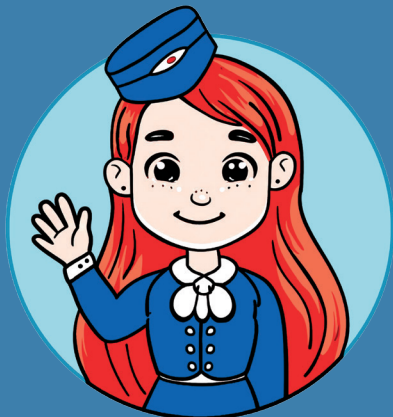


NATIONAL TRAIN DAY AT THE MS AG MUSEUM

- Complete all 5-train station stops for a complimentary train ride.

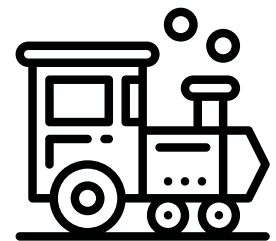


MAY 10TH 9AM-1PM
