VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES & DESCRIPTIONS

VOLUNTEER COLLECTIONS ASSISTANT

Purpose:

Assist Museum Collections Director with the processing, cleaning and upkeep of the museum collections. This will include training of proper handling, care, and cleaning of artifacts.

Responsibilities:

- Assist museum staff with cleaning and preparing artifacts for placement in the museum collections
- Assist museum staff with documenting/cataloging artifacts and data entry of cataloged information
- Assist museum staff in presenting "touch stations" including artifacts in the education collection

Qualifications:

- Ability to work well with others
- Ability to perform well under time constraints
- Ability to lift objects weighing up to 25lbs
- Knowledge of computers and data entry processing

Requirements:

- Successfully complete training
- Successfully complete training on proper care and maintenance of artifacts in the collections
- Dependability

Time Commitment:

• Twelve (12) hours of volunteer service per year at the Ag Museum are required to remain on the active volunteer list

GROUNDS ASSISTANT

Purpose:

Gardening and horticulture based work. Assist the grounds and maintenance staff with the general upkeep of various gardens and flower beds throughout the nearly 40 acres of Museum grounds.

Responsibilities:

- Assist museum staff with planting, maintaining and harvesting gardens and various crops.
- Assist with watering and pruning
- Assist with maintaining visual standards of the grounds and nature trails.

Qualifications:

- Ability to work well with others
- Ability to lift objects weighing up to 25lbs
- General gardening knowledge a plus

Requirements:

- Successfully complete training
- Dependability

Time Commitment:

• Twelve (12) hours of volunteer service per year at the Ag Museum are required to remain on the active volunteer list

EDUCATION/SPECIAL EVENT ASSISTANT

Purpose:

Assist Museum Staff with educational programing and special events at the Museum, as well as outreach opportunities within the community. With monthly educational programs, special events and offsite community outreach opportunities, the Museum needs volunteers to assist in creating and executing these programs and events.

Responsibilities:

- Assist museum staff with creating and facilitating educational/outreach programs offered by the museum
- Assist museum staff by acting as a museum ambassador during community events and opportunities (Story Time, Fondren First Thursdays, etc.)
- Assist museum staff during special events with general set up and breakdown.

GALLERY HOST

Purpose:

To provide visitors with information that will enrich their visit to the Ag Museum and to Mississippi. This information shall educate the public about the history and continuing impact of agriculture and forestry in the state and the importance of historic preservation.

Responsibilities:

- Monitor the Heritage Center Gallery while visitors are present.
- Ensure that visitors do not touch or interact with artifacts.
- Assist Docent/Tour Guide with large group tours.
- Help maintain visual standards in the Gallery by completing Gallery Checklist
- Give a very brief overview of the site if Docent/Tour Guide is unavailable

Qualifications:

- Knowledge of computers and data entry processing
- Ability to work well with others
- Knowledge of subject matter and experience with public interaction
- Ability to convey knowledge and information in an interesting manner
- Ability to relate well to people of all ages, backgrounds, and education levels
- Ability to lift objects weighing up to 25lbs

Requirements:

- Successfully complete training
- Dependability

Time Commitment:

• Twelve (12) hours of volunteer service per year at the Ag Museum are required to remain on the active volunteer list

Qualifications:

- Knowledge of subject matter

- Pleasant personality with the ability to relate to all ages, backgrounds, & educational levels
- Excellent customer service skills

- Twelve (12) hours of volunteer service per year at the Ag Museum are required to remain on the active volunteer list

DOCENT/TOUR GUIDE

Purpose:

To provide visitors with information that will enrich their visit to the Museum and to Mississippi. This information shall educate the public about the history and continuing impact of agriculture and forestry in the state, and the importance of historic preservation.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in greeting visitors and/or groups
- Escort the group to the auditorium for orientation
- Conduct a very brief overview of the site including guidelines
- Operate basic audiovisual equipment
- Guide visitors through the Heritage Center exhibits

Qualifications:

- Some knowledge of subject matter
- Ability to convey knowledge in an interesting manner
- Agreeable personality
- Ability to relate well to people of all ages, backgrounds, and educational levels

Requirements:

- Successfully complete tour guide training (will require a written and oral exam)
- Dependability

Time Commitment:

• Twelve (12) hours of volunteer service per year at the Ag Museum are required to remain on the active volunteer list

SKILLED DEMONSTRATOR

Purpose:

To provide visitors with information that will enrich their visit to the Museum and to Mississippi. This information shall educate the public about the history and continuing impact of agriculture and forestry in the state, and the importance of historic preservation.

Responsibilities:

- Skilled Demonstrator must have an existing knowledge of a specific craft or skill (ex. Forge Council, Woodturner, Print shop, spinning wheel, etc.)
- Skilled Demonstrators provide a living example of many of the artifacts found on the grounds of the Museum.

Qualifications:

- Proficient knowledge of subject matter
- Ability to convey knowledge in an interesting manner
- Agreeable personality
- Ability to relate well to people of all ages, backgrounds, and educational levels

Requirements:

- Successfully complete training
- In certain areas, must be a member of the specific guild or club
- Dependability

• Twelve (12) hours of volunteer service per year at the Ag Museum are required to remain on the active volunteer list
